**PRO:** Despite losing first two starts, remains with upside. **CON:** Hard to endorse a maiden in a spot like this.

# **OWEN ALMIGHTY**



**PRO:** Consistent colt disqualified in Pasco S. though clearly best. **CON:** Can't afford to set Pasco-like fractions over this longer trip.

#### **POSTER**



**PRO:** Godolphin homebred showed versatility winning Remsen (G2) in dirt debut. **CON:** Nearly caught in that Aqueduct feature and must avoid losing focus.

## **NAUGHTY RASCAL**



**PRO:** Three-time stakes winner was elevated to first in the Pasco last time. **CON:** Lone win around two turns occurred on the grass; improvement needed.

## **SMOKEN BOY**



**PRO:** A leading juvenile in Puerto Rico last season and won a lucrative stakes there. **CON:** Competition on the U.S. mainland is much tougher; has never run over a fast track.
